## **EDUCATIONAL ATTAINMENT**

St Juliana once again upheld its impressive record of 100% result in the class 10<sup>th</sup> examination in the year 2024 -25. Excellence in academics is the hall mark of any good educational institution. We are proud to announce the board examination result of 2025.

The following students are the toppers in the respective class.

1. Antony Shinoy from commerce secured 97.8 % with full A1
2. Ellis Francis Elroy from computer science secured 96.6% with full A1

33 students appeared for the 12<sup>th</sup> board examination in the last year. Out of them got two full A1, four 90 % and above, nine 80% and above, seven 70 % and above and rest of them secured good results.

The school commemorated Onam, the harvest festival of Kerala, with a vibrant programme that blended cultural authenticity with the spirit of unity.


Students' created intricate flower carpet designs a representing particular theme. Inter-house competition was conducted.

## **INFRA-STRUCTURE**



Our students and parents are so kind hearted and generous towards the poor and needy. They extended


their helping hand and concern to one of our students who was seriously admitted in the hospital and needed a lot of money for the further treatment. With their help she could recover from her sickness.

## **CONCLUSION**


